

# RULES OF PROCEDURES

CAMPING Le FUN - 11510 Fitou

## 1 - CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION

Only persons authorized by the manager\* are authorized to enter or stay on the campsite. Entering or staying on the campsite implies acceptance of the provisions of these regulations and the commitment to comply with them.

## 2 - IDENTIFICATION

Anyone entering or staying on the campsite must first present to the manager\* an identity document and complete the police formalities. Minors unaccompanied by their parents will only be admitted with their written authorization and must be accompanied by an adult.

## 3 - INSTALLATION

Vehicles, tents, caravans and camping equipment must be set up at the location indicated, in accordance with the guidelines given by the manager\*.

## 4 - VISITORS

After having been authorized by the manager \*, visitors can be admitted to the campsite under the responsibility of the clients who receive them and must respect the internal rules of the campsite. Visitors admitted to the campsite will have to pay a fee allowing them to have access to the campsite facilities. Unless authorized by the manager \*, visitors' cars are prohibited on the campsite.

## 5 - ANIMALS

Animals must be kept on a leash. They must not be left free or left alone at the campsite, even locked up or tied up. Animal droppings must be collected by their owners. Category 1 and 2 dogs are not allowed. Animals must be vaccinated. Their up-to-date vaccination record can be requested from their owner.

## 6 - TRANQUILITY

Customers must avoid any noise or discussion that may disturb their neighbors.

## 7 - VEHICLE TRAFFIC AND PARKING

Inside the campsite the speed is limited to 10 km / h. Parking should not interfere with traffic or the installation of customers.

## 8 - RESPECT FOR FACILITIES - HYGIENE - CLEANLINESS

Each customer must refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite and its facilities. The pitch used during the stay must be kept clean throughout the stay. Plantations, fences and campsite facilities must be respected. Any degradation noted by the manager\* will be the responsibility of its author.

## 9 - HOUSEHOLD WASTE - WASTE - SELECTIVE SORTING

The bins located on the campsite are intended exclusively for non-recyclable waste. Glasses, plastics, cardboard boxes and newspapers must be thrown in the selective sorting containers located at the entrance to the campsite (green and yellow containers).

## 10 - SECURITY

Open fires (wood, charcoal, etc.) are strictly prohibited. Stoves, gas barbecues, camping gas, must be kept in good working order and used with care. In the event of a fire, immediately notify the campsite manager \*. Fire extinguishers can only be used when necessary.

For tents only a number of gas cylinders with a total fuel weight not exceeding 6 kg is allowed.

For campervans, caravans and mobile homes, only a number of gas cylinders with a total fuel weight not exceeding 26 kg is permitted.

A first aid kit is available at reception.

The management is not responsible for any thefts committed inside the campsite.

## 11 - PLAYGROUNDS

The playgrounds (except City Stadium) are for children aged 2 to 12 years old. For safety reasons and to preserve the equipment, no other person is permitted to use these games. All the playgrounds are under the supervision of parents.

## 12 - SWIMMING POOL

Access to the swimming pool is reserved for campsite guests and their visitors. The opening hours of the swimming pool are indicated at the entrance of the latter. It is forbidden to enter the pool with shoes. The shower is compulsory before each bath. The complete rules of procedure for the swimming pool are displayed at the entrance to the swimming pool.

## 13 - RULES OF PROCEDURES DISPLAY

The rules of procedure are posted at the entrance to the campsite and at reception. A copy may be requested at reception.

## 14 - BREACH OF INTERNAL REGULATIONS

In the event of a serious or repeated breach of these internal regulations and after formal notice by the manager\* to comply with them, the latter may exclude him from the campsite without delay or reimbursement of the remaining stay.
